***Stonehenge:***

A circle of very large stones built in ancient times in southern England

***Bronze Age:***

The time in the past when tools and weapons were made of bronze (= a brown metal made of copper and tin), before iron was discovered

**Nouns**

<b><i>Atomic bomb</i></b>	A bomb that uses the explosive power of dividing atoms
<b><i>Business</i></b>	A person's regular occupation, profession or trade OR the practice of making one's living by engaging in commerce
<b><i>Computer</i></b>	An electronic device for storing and processing data, typically in binary form, according to instructions given to it in a variable program
<b><i>Crown</i></b>	A circular decoration for the head, usually made of gold and jewels (= precious stones), and worn by a king or queen at official ceremonies
<b><i>Emperor</i></b>	A male ruler of an Empire
<b><i>Enemy</i></b>	A person who hates or opposes another person and tries to harm them or stop them from doing something
<b><i>Experiment</i></b>	A test done in order to learn something or to discover if something works or is true



<b>Message</b>	A verbal, written, or recorded communication sent to or left for a recipient who cannot be contacted directly
<b>Painter</b>	Someone who paints pictures
<b>Physics</b>	The scientific study of matter and energy and the effect that they have on each other
<b>Robot</b>	A machine controlled by a computer that is used to perform jobs automatically
<b>Stone</b>	The hard, solid substance found in the ground that is often used for building, or a piece of this
<b>Survivor</b>	A person who continues to live, despite nearly dying
<b>Time Machine</b>	(Especially in stories and films) a machine in which people can travel into the past or the future
<b>Uraninite</b>	A black, grey, or brown mineral which consists mainly of uranium dioxide and is the chief ore of uranium
<b>Uranium</b>	A chemical element that is a heavy, radioactive metal, used in the production of nuclear power and in some types of nuclear weapon
<b>War</b>	A state of armed conflict between different nations or states or different groups within a nation or state

<b><i>Belong</i></b>	Be the property of
<b><i>Conquer</i></b>	To take control or possession of foreign land, or a group of people, by force
<b><i>Destroy</i></b>	Put an end to the existence of (something) by damaging or attacking it
<b><i>Greet</i></b>	To welcome someone with particular words or a particular action, or to react to something in the stated way
<b><i>Travel</i></b>	To make a journey, usually over a long distance
