Classroom Activities

Didactic Focus

- Speaking with intention (persuasion)
- Rhyme and musicality

Classroom Activities

1. List and pronounce food/objects from the lyrics
2. Roleplay seller/buyer in pairs
3. Design your own market stall poster

4. “Truth or Lie?” speaking game



Theme: Courage – Identity – Determination

Classroom Activities

3. Underline “power” words in the lyrics
4. Discuss: What makes a character evil?



Theme : Hope – Self-belief – Moving forward

(Finale – Celebration and reflection)

3. “Our Light” classroom mural with drawings and words
4. Optional: rehearse and perform the chorus as class closure
